Celebrated Worlds Aids Day By organizing Walkathon

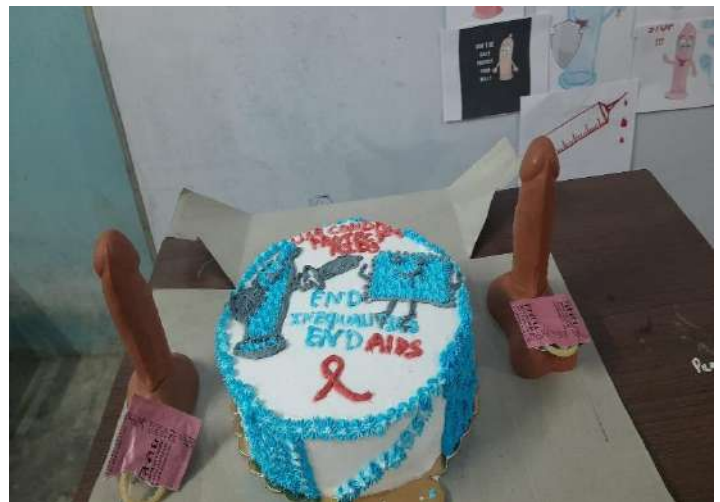

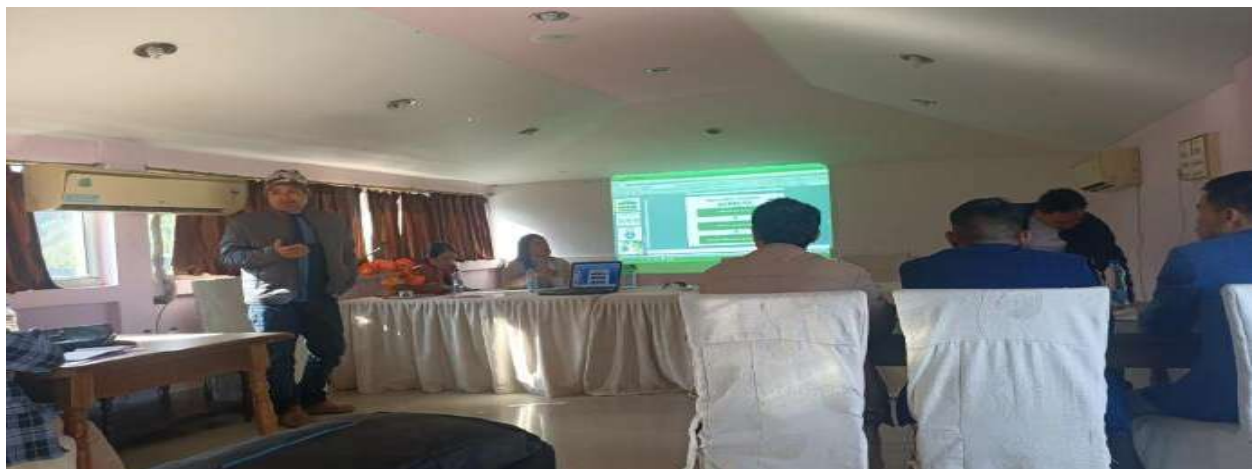


Chairperson as resources person on drug problem and responsible of mothers toward their children

The Targeted Intervention (TI) project Arunachal Pradesh state AIDS Control Society (APSACS) have been awarded to Mother's Vision (NGO) on 1st. August 2018. Along with following post.

- 3. ANM -----1 Post**
- 4. ORW ----- 3 Post**

Along with 12 (nine) PEER Educator.

The purpose of including TI-Project programmed under Mother's Vision (NGO) is one of most important prevention strategies under APSACS and then NACO. The TI- Project comprise of preventive intervention among HRGs. It includes, core high risk group such as Female sex worker (FSW) men sex with men (MSM), injecting Drugs user (IDUs), Female Drug User and transgender/Hijras.

TI project provide a package of prevention, support and linkage service to HRGs throughout reach-base service delivering model which include screening and treatment of sexually transmitted infected (STI) and also free testing for tuberculosis patients (TB). The people of high-risk group communities are engaged to deliver service and act as agent.

TI Project provide free condom and lubricant distributed among core group, behavior change communication (BCC) and also, we provide free needle and syringe for injecting drugs user to reduce possibility of sharing needle and syringe and treated the STD.

In case if we found among of community positive result, we provide them all necessity and accommodation as we link up them ART, and provide medicine etc.

Aims and Objective of TI- Project:

The **Main Aims** main aims and objective of TI project is to prevent HIV/AIDS through sexually transmitted and sharing and needles & syringe

1. To prevent targeted intervention Female sex worker (FSW)
2. men sex with men (MSM)
3. To prevent needle-syringes exchange programmed of Injecting drugs user (IDUs) Both Male& Female Injecting Drug Users)
4. To prevent transgender/Hijras
5. To prevent sexually transmitted disease (STI)
6. To prevent Reproductive tract infection (RTI)

Services of the Project

1. To provide Free counselling and testing of HIV & Syphilis
2. To provide Free testing of tuberculosis (TB)
3. To free distribution of needles and syringe
4. To Free distribution of condom and lubricant Given target to conduct a test on monthly bases at the average of:
 1. MSM --- 9 to 10 HRG
 2. FSW --- 10 to 12 HRG
 3. IDU ---- 10 to 12 HRG
 4. TB. ---- 2 to 4 HRG
 5. FIDU..... 5 TO 6
 6. Hepatitis. Hep-c – limit less
 7. HIV. – ---- limit less

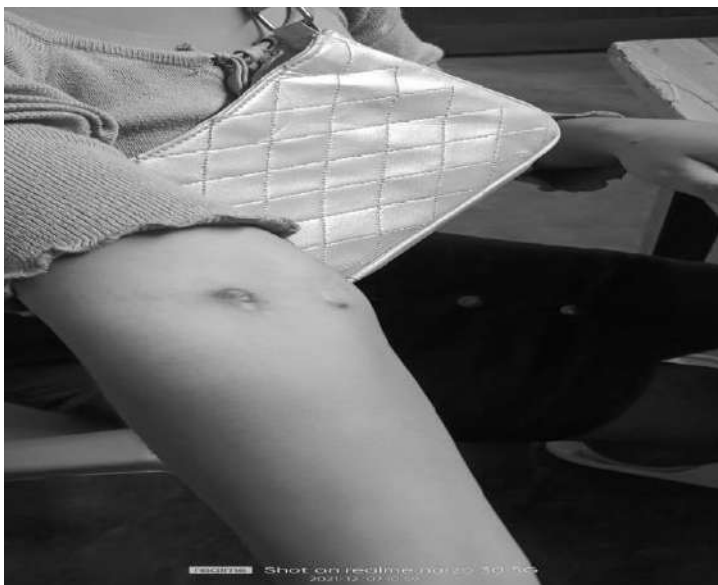

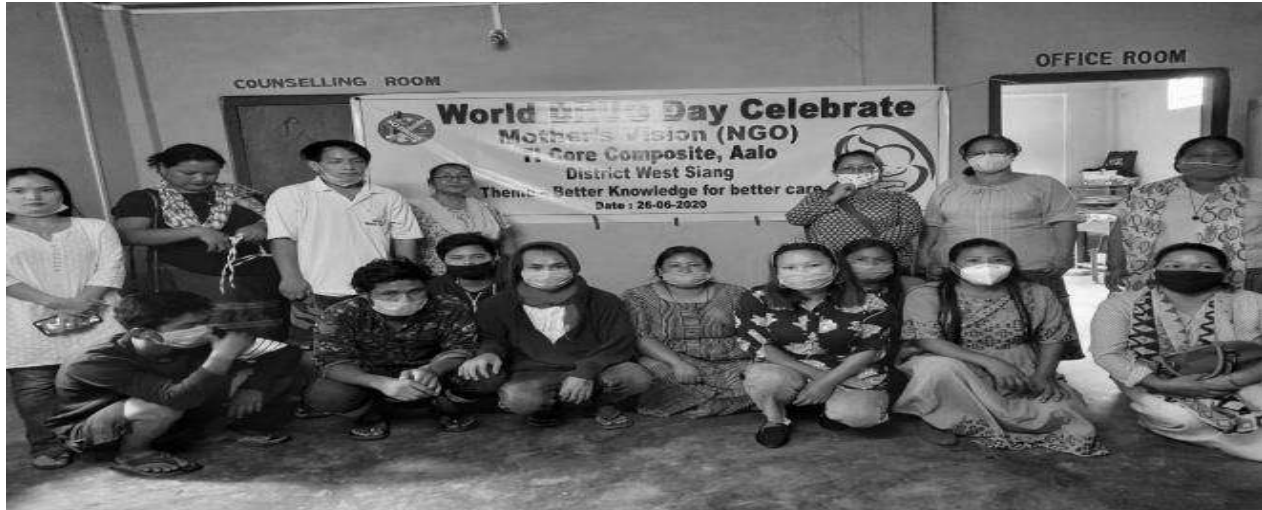

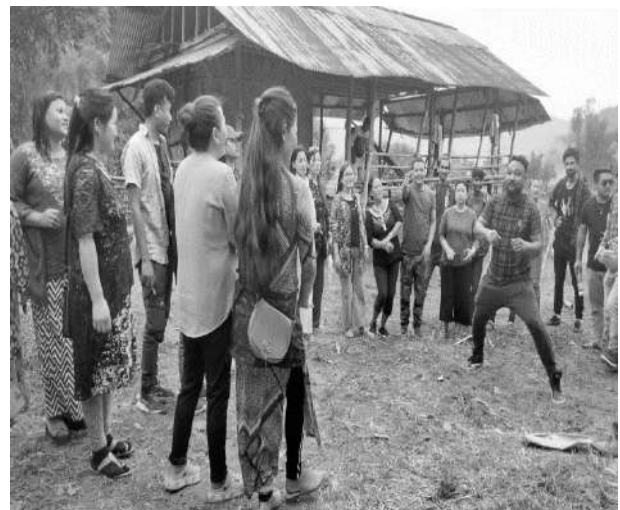
